

BLACK HILLS, BUFFALO & BADLANDS

September 23-29, 2010

Depart Springfield, MO for Kearney, NE. Admission to Great Platte River Road Archway. Lodging at Comfort Inn.

Day 2, Friday, September 24

Today we travel to Rapid City, SD which will be our hub for the entire trip. Tour of City of Presidents. Four nights lodging at Comfort Inn.

Day 3, Saturday, September 25

Today we see the Crazy Horse Memorial and attend the 45th Annual Buffalo Arts Festival. In the afternoon we have a wildlife tour at Custer State Park and then have dinner and see the sights at Mount Rushmore.
